C. Craig Frazier, founding Brother of Metagenes, died on Friday, December 31, 1993, after a long and courageous battle with cancer. Services were held at the Denver Dharmadhatu, a Buddist meditation center of which he was a founding member. Craig enjoyed a 16-year career as an Architect with the National Park Service.
