1996 Library Benefit

Three years ago the Brothers of the Metagenes Chapter of Alpha Rho Chi in cooperation with the Art and Architecture Library in Cowgill Hall, created the Library Benefit. The Inaugural Library Benefit consisted of the raffling of a replica Eileen Gray table and the auctioning of artwork and architectural objects donated by architecture students and faculty.

The proceeds from this enormously successful event enabled the Art and Architecture Library to purchase much needed and otherwise unaffordable equipment. As a result of the popularity of the first Library Benefit, the Metagenes Chapter hoped to make this an annual occurrence.

The chapter was able to hold a second benefit the following year but unfortunately, last year was unable to carry out the Library Benefit. Again this year, financial and membership limitations may force cancellation. The Metagenes Alumni Association, however, can provide the necessary resources to once again sponsor the Library Benefit.
